- **When are applications due?**
Applications are due by 5:00 PM CT on May 10, 2023.
- **Can I apply for more than one fellowship?** Of course! Please submit a completed application for each role.
- **I'm Latinx, but I'm not bilingual. Does this mean I shouldn't apply?** Nope! We like to include Spanish translations and Spanish sprinkles in our text, especially on social media, but you do not have to be bilingual. However, Spanish speakers are highly encouraged to apply!
- **Do you have to identify as Latinx to apply for a fellowship?** No, we love our allies and supporters. However, Latinx and BIPOC folx are highly encouraged to apply!
- **Can I still apply if I don't have historic preservation or conservation experience?** Please do! All we ask is that you're passionate about saving Latinx heritage. Find out more qualifications in each job posting.

- **Who will be selected/Can you describe the ideal candidate?** We are looking for graduate students that are hard-working, passionate about saving Latinx heritage, comfortable working independently, have experience working with/for Latinx organizations and have the desire to learn and educate.
- **Are there days I will have to attend meetings in-person?** Depending on your fellowship. The Preservation, Film, and Photography Fellowship will travel to historic sites in Texas.
- **When will the fellows be selected/informed?** The week of May 30, 2023
- **If accepted, what is the time commitment?** The start date is June 19, 2023. The end date is August 11, 2023. Fellows are required to work 15 hours a week. Mondays and Wednesdays from 10 am CT to 2 pm CT should be reserved for meetings.
- **I graduated Summer 2022. Can I still apply for a fellowship?** Unfortunately, no. These opportunities are for folx who have graduated in the last 8 calendar months.
